

If you transfer to the **University of Arizona**, statewide transfer policies are in place to allow you to seamlessly transition from your community college to the university and be right on track in the College of Education. Bachelor's degree requirements are listed with Maricopa transfer equivalencies at **degreesearch.arizona.edu**. In addition, UA's transfer center (**transfer.arizona.edu**) offers advisement and academic and social activities designed to support transfer students.

Out-of-State and Private Universities






Start at a Maricopa Community College

The Maricopa Community Colleges provide an affordable way for you to progress toward a bachelor's degree. You can complete the first two years at a Maricopa college near you and then transfer to a 4-year college or university. You will save money, learn from highly qualified faculty, and get to know yourself as a student by starting your college education at a Maricopa Community College.

Transfer Options for Education Majors

While you can transfer anywhere, the Maricopa Community Colleges have established transfer partnerships with quality, reputable colleges and universities. These university partnerships help you transition smoothly from one institution to the next by maximizing the applicability of your Maricopa Community College credits. In addition, many university partners offer you early advisement and transcript evaluation, as well as financial incentives such as transfer scholarships, waived application fees, textbook waivers, and special tuition incentives for military personnel.



The **Maricopa-Arizona State University Pathways Program (MAPP)** is a cost-effective pathway ensuring all courses transfer and apply to an ASU degree. As an education major, when you meet all MAPP requirements, you are guaranteed admission to ASU and to the Mary Lou Fulton Teachers College. In addition, MAPP completers are eligible for a tuition commitment which provides limits on tuition increases during enrollment at ASU. The **Northern Arizona University Connection** allows you to "Keep Learning Without Leaving" with programs throughout Maricopa County in elementary education with various concentration areas, and a combination of elementary and special education. Plus, through the Connect2NAU joint admissions program, you can earn a renewable \$2000 merit scholarship and gain access to NAU resources and advisement while you attend your community college.
