2. PROOF OF GRADUATION FROM SECONDARY SCHOOL

Original <u>or</u> certified copies of official diploma or certificate from each secondary school (high school), college or university, and/or technical school you have attended. If your official documents were issued in a language other than English, you must submit the official documents in the original language **AND** an official translation of the documents. An official translation is a precise, word-for-word English translation of the documents that has been prepared by the issuing institution or a professional translator. *Unofficial photocopies, color copies, scans, color scans, faxes, attachments, downloads and internet printouts of secondary school documents cannot be accepted.*

3. EVIDENCE OF ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

(waived for students whose native language is English)

a. Admission to Academic Programs

Applicants who wish to enroll in an academic program at the college must present evidence of their level of English language proficiency. There are several different methods that can be used to satisfy this requirement:

- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL): The applicant must attain a score of at least 500 on the paper-based test, 173 on the computer based test, or 61 on the Internet-based test. (Note: SMCC's institution code is 4734.)
- International English Language Testing System (IELTS): The applicant must attain an overall IELTS Band Score of 5.5 or better. A minimum IELTS individual Band Score of 5.0 in EACH module is recommended.
- STEP Eiken test (for Japanese students): Pre-1 level or better is required.
- Appropriate scores on Maricopa Community College's placement tests: Accuplacer, ASSET, COMPASS or CELSA.

Please note: Regardless of TOEFL or IELTS scores, <u>all new students are required to take placements tests upon arrival at South Mountain Community College.</u>

4. EVIDENCE OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- a. You or your sponsor(s) must complete the Statement of Financial Support, which states that there are sufficient funds to cover your educational and living expenses, estimated at \$20,230 (in USD) per year, and are willing to use this money to pay for your academic and living expenses while you are attending South Mountain Community College. *Please see the Proposed Budget information for details.*
- b. IMPORTANT: You or your sponsor MUST also include OFFICIAL & ORIGINAL bank statements or an OFFICIAL & ORIGINAL letter from the bank (on bank letterhead and signed by a bank official) showing that the sponsor has sufficient funds on deposit.

If submitting the official letter from the bank: The official letter must be written on bank letterhead bearing the bank's address, telephone number, fax number, web address, and bank official's original signature and stamp. The letter must include the account holder's name, address, account number, the approximate date the account was opened, that the account is in good standing, and the current account balance in USD. *We cannot accept bank letters that do not state that a balance in excess of \$20,230 (in USD) is available.* If submitting bank statements, they must be for a consecutive three month period. Bank statements must reference the account holder's name, address and account number as well as be printed on bank letterhead. We will not accept bank statements older than six months before the start date of your intended semester of study.

*Faxes, photocopies, color copies, scans, color scans, attachments, downloads and internet printouts of financial documents will not be accepted. Evidence of financial support will be required prior for issuance of the I-20 form. Please note that the U.S. Consulate will require another set of original financial documents when you apply for the F-1 visa. The college has no scholarship or financial aid provisions for international students; therefore, students must be fully prepared to meet the necessary financial obligations for the entire time they will be in the United States.

5. A PHOTOCOPY OF YOUR PASSPORT

A copy of the pages with identification information (including the picture page) and expiration date is required. The passport must be valid for at least six months. If your spouse and/or children will accompany you, please provide photocopies of their passports as well.

Additional requirements if you are applying from within the United States:

- 6. A photocopy of the I-94
- 7. A photocopy of your current visa in your passport
- 8. An official transcript from the previous educational institution sent directly to South Mountain Community College
- 9. Photocopies of all prior SEVIS I-20 documents
- 10. SEVIS Transfer form, completed and signed by both the student and the current international student advisor/DSO
- 11. Approval Notice of Change of Status, if applicable
