About MEMS

The Maricopa Emergency Management System (MEMS) is an emergency notification system being used by Maricopa districtwide to communicate emergency messaging to all students, employees, and interested parties. Emergency alerts are sent via text and email through RAVE and via physical hardware such as wall-mounted beacons and speakers through Alertus.

College Admins

College Admins are able to send emergency alerts to their **affiliated college** via RAVE. Typical scenarios are non-police-related and may include the following:

- Road Closures and Parking Lot Closures
- Building Construction
- Class Closures

District Dispatcher Admins

District Dispatcher Admins are able to send emergency alerts **districtwide** via RAVE and Alertus. Typical scenarios may include the following:

- Active Shooter on Campus
- Campus Lockdown or Lockout
- Health Safety Hazard
- Police Situation Near Campus or Crime Safety Warnings
