Always Wear Your Face Covering

Wear your face covering in common areas at all times when not actively eating or drinking or alone in an office or remote location. As soon as you are done with these activities, place your covering back on your face.



Social distance from individuals without facecoverings while eating and drinking, including in: breakrooms, workrooms, workstations, cafeteria, and courtyards.



Wash your hands before and after you touch your covering. Store it in a paper bag when not using. Wash and dry your covering at the end of each day.
